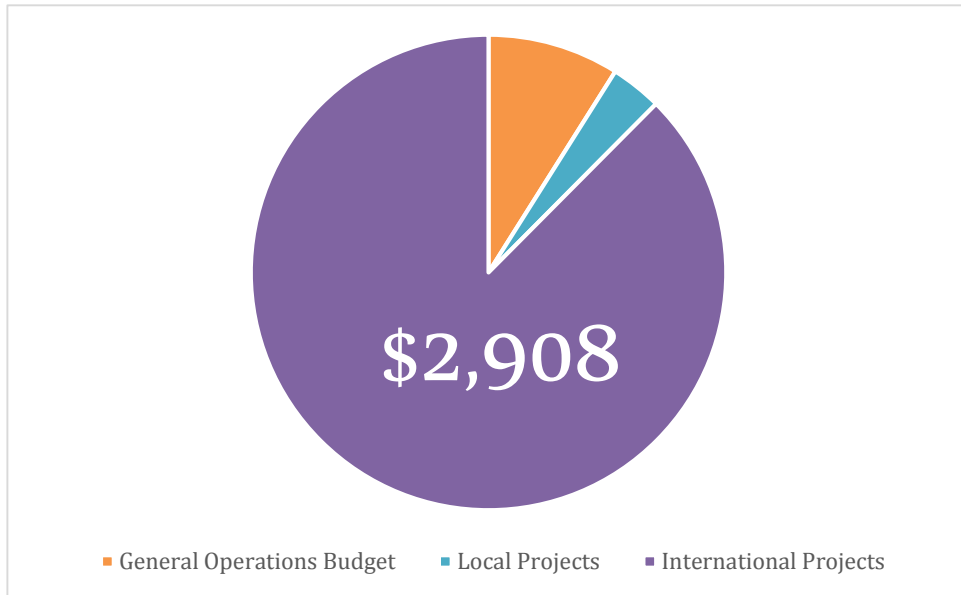

LOCAL PROJECTS

This year our chapter spent countless hours volunteering at Helping Hands, a local foster home and Mauldin Miracle League, a baseball league for children with special needs. We also began volunteering with Family Effect, a rehab center for women. We were happy to be able to fund some local projects this year in addition to volunteering our time!

Helping Hands Supply Donation:

After spending time with the children at Helping Hands our chapter chose to make a donation of supplies and other necessities. Supplies purchased included, paper products, cleaning supplies, personal hygiene items, sunscreen, pajamas, movies and popcorn!

INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS

Adopt-A-Project: Dominican Republic

Our chapter made two monetary donations of \$525 and \$570 each to the FIMRC Site in the DR. These funds were used to buy the supplies for and construct three latrines and support the program Agentes de Salud. Through the Agentes de Salud program the FIMRC site was able to educate students about local health issues such as STD's, sanitation and chronic disease management.
